Successful Living

Today we will be talking about four kinds of Birds:

NB: (There's feathered birds, pretty birds and ugly birds. Most of the pretty birds are male birds).

1. Throughout the Bible God uses birds as an analogy.
 - a) The Holy Spirit - The Dove
 - b) Satan - The bird that eats the seed.
 - c) God fed the Israelites – Quail

Flesh devouring birds:

1. The first bird - The Vulture:

- a). Vultures are ugly looking birds, they look like Turkey's so are their wings.
Vultures are scavengers, flesh eaters they will first go for the eyes.
Vultures feed on dead flesh and on carcasses.
Vultures are known to gather with other vultures in anticipation for their prey.

- b). As the Vulture, his eyes are looking for the young.
- c) But there is also good in a Vulture. The Vulture rids the world of the rot and stench.

2. The second bird – The Eagle:

- a) The Eagle is a large bird of prey, with a keen vision and of powerful flight, it's wing span is over two meters and it's beak is crooked and furnished with a cere at the base, so as to rip through flesh. It has strong muscles and powerful claws. It has been recorded that they can live up to 104years long.
- b) The Eagle has a keen vision, sharp sight is powerful and swift flight. He is able to see a great distance and fly through and above storms.

Proverbs 29 v 18 : We need the swiftness of the Eagle to be at the cutting edge.

2 Timothy 4 v 2 : We must be instant in season and out of season.

- c) We need to go through the storms so we can use them to our advantage
- d). God has given the eagle strong wings, claws and a beak.
- e). God has given you the Holy Spirit and the Word, His amounting, the blood of Jesus to overcome.

3. The third bird – The Sparrow (Mossie)

- a) He does not fly like the eagle or as swift as the eagle. In fact it's an imbalanced bird.
- b) He avoids storms, nobody wants him in their cages, he's ugly and cannot sing well, but likes to chirp.
- c) You will always find them on the ground they feel safe on the ground.
- d) Do not be high minded, God resists the proud.....

4. The fourth bird – The Canary

The Canary is a beautiful bird with all the different colours; Blue, White, Yellow, what a combination. They are known by their singing. Their beauty and their singing, it creates a perception that they should be put in a cage to be admired. Do not let people create your world.
