Covenant Relationship with God

Jeremiah 31 v 31 to 34

The Covenant is the strongest and most enduring relationship between God and His people.

Hebrew 8 v 6 to 12

There is reasons why the New Covenant is better than the Old Covenant

1. The Old Covenant was confirmed through the blood of bulls and goats (animal sacrifice).
The New Covenant is ratified by the blood of Jesus Christ.

Hebrew 9 v 11 to 14

If God did not send His Son "Jesus Christ" we would've still been functioning under the Old Testament. It's established through the blood, = the everlasting Covenant.

2. There circumcision was of the flesh, our circumcision is of the heart.

Genesis 17 v 9 to 14

The sign of the Covenant was Circumcision

Acts 15

Dissension arose about Circumcision

Romans 2 v 28 to 29

Sealed with the Holy Spirit of Praise

Ephesians 1 v 13 (Message Bible)

3. In the Old Covenant they were servants, in the New Covenant we are sons and daughters of God.

John 15 v 14 to 16

Romans 8 v 14 to 17

Joint heirs with (Servants do not get an inheritance) but a son/s and daughter/s do.

4. In the Old Covenant they had Atonement of sin, and in the New Covenant we have remission of sin.

Atonement: A cover up = blood cover their sin.

There were conscience of sin, they had a sin conscience.

Remission: To cancel the debt of sin = Jesus paid for your sin in full.

2 Corinthians 5 v 21

He was made sin = now I am righteous

5. **Great exchange:**

Colossians 2 v 13 to 14 (Message Bible)

In the Old Covenant, God's presence would manifest in the Holy of Holies once a year.

In the New Covenant we have God's presence living inside of us.

1 Corinthians 6 v 19 to 20

Your body is God's dwelling place

1 John 4 v 4

6. In the Old Covenant they tried to obtain Salvation by the law. In the New Covenant we are saved by grace. The Old Covenant is based on word = The New Covenant is based on GRACE.

Ephesians 2 v 1 to 9 (Amplified bible)

Grace: God's riches at Christ's expense
