WORSHIP

During your worship time allow time for the Holy Spirit to use people in the gifts of the Spirit
eg: Tongues and interpretations of prophecy; be sensitive to what the Holy Spirit is showing you concerning the needs of the people and what you need to do.
Encourage the people to exercise the gifts of the spirit.

OFFERING

Do an offering of your choice, delegate someone for next week.

NB: Remember to share with your people the purpose of **cell offering**. It is used to meet the needs of the poor in our communities.

WORD

Reach one for Christ - are you reaching one for Christ. Who is your one?

MESSENGERS

We as a church have a great door of opportunity to our community to be an influence.

There are people who are living with no hope and despair, because of leaders of the nation that have not kept their promise!! (They promised to create jobs, while another 70,000 is unemployed) The unemployment rate just goes up and up.

1. **We have the ability to influence other people**

Mark 16 v 15: The good news

- a) Go into your world, where you live. – We must all preach the Gospel, on occasions we must use some words (The Word).
- b) The saying goes: that our life style, our attitude and our motives speaks louder than words.
- c) We as messengers of the Good news, must not allow ourselves to get caught up in negativity, strife, and corruption.

Matthew 5 v 13 to 16 (Message Bible)

2. **We need to bring a new focus**

For us to bring hope to the world is to have a new focus, there are things we have to do:

a) **To change our dialogue:**

Changing our dialogue is to change the way we behave and speak to others.

Colossians 4 v 6

Let your speech be seasoned with salt.

Matthew 5 v 13

You are here to be salt seasoning and to bring out the God flavour on the earth.

b) **Change your conversation from blaming others.**

It's always easy to blame others for what's going on.

You cannot live your life on other people's mistakes.

c) **Speech that blames others:**

They promised; they said that they were going to; they did not.

d) **Bring your focus to "an accountability and responsibility".**

Speaking and thinking: I can / I will / I am making a difference in my world.

3. **Pressing the reset button.**

Reset your expectation about things

a) People that live under false expectations of what others will do for them. Change your expectation from men to God.

Hebrews 11 v 1

Hope for confident expectations, "God said that what He will do, He will do".

b) Put not your faith in man, but put your faith in God.

- . We need strong families
- . We need peace of mind by being grateful about what we have, and not what we want.
- . We need to acknowledge God first in our lives, and be more fruitful for God.
- . Reset your button of some old time values.

Respect and honour

We send out a message to others by the way we live. We must show respect and honour to others.

1 Peter 2 v 17

Honour all men everybody has the right to respect

Respect people: Let us start respecting ourselves first, therefore we will be able to respect others.
